I intend to leave the rides as a general rule at 12.30 any alteration to start times made at the discretion of the ride leader. Saturday rides seem to have got longer and longer recently and it won't be much time before the afternoons draw in. It may be that we have a natural progression to earlier starts just to get the rides finished before we all have to go out and buy a set of lights. The solution is if you want an early start Saturday think of a ride volunteer to lead it and you can set off whatever time you like!

Probably similar plan to last year grab a group of mates, book a chalet and sort it out between you.
